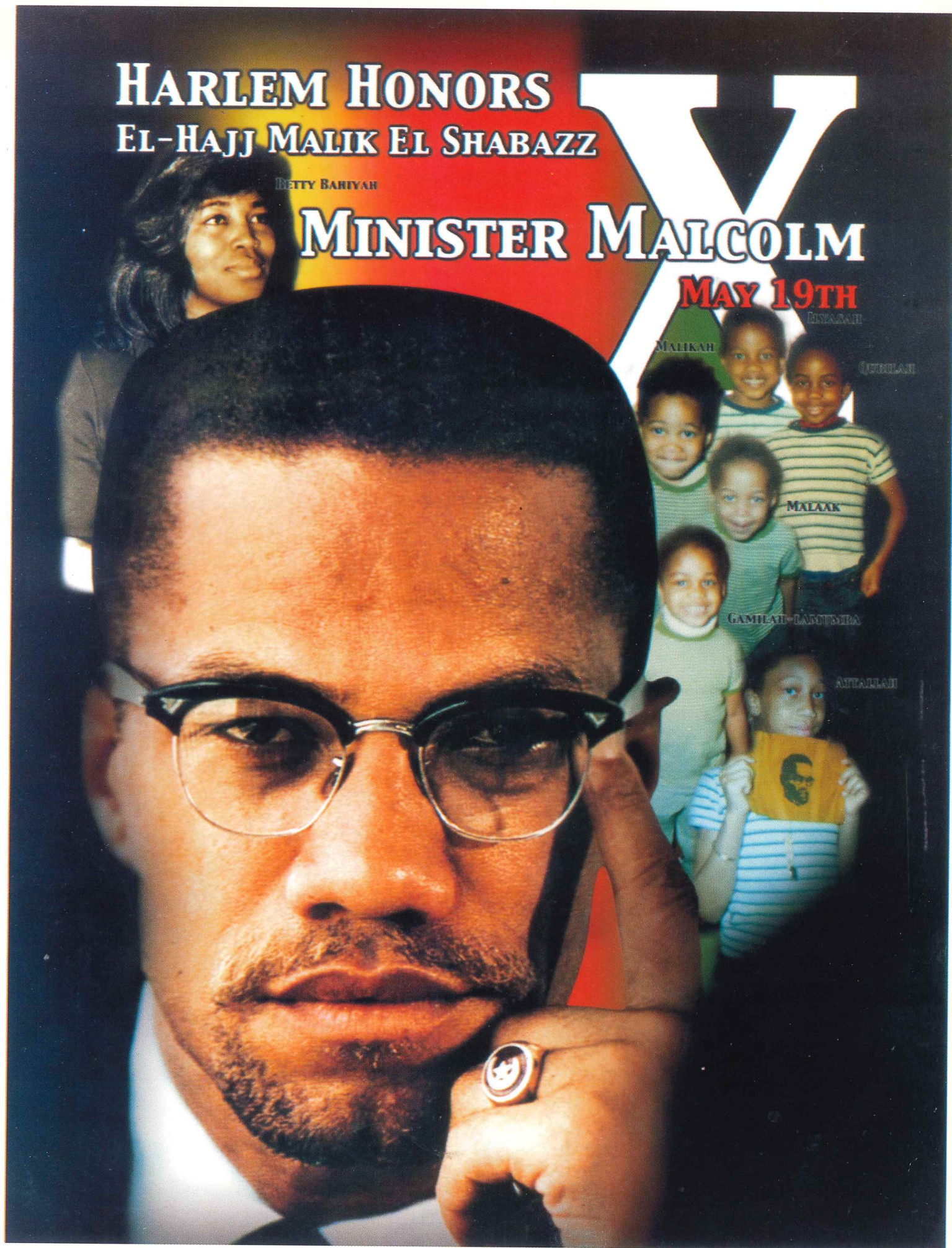

Gamilah-Lamumba Shabazz, Ilyasah Shabazz and Malaak Shabazz will take center stage today to announce Harlem's community-wide celebration honoring the birthday of their martyred father, El-Hajj Malik El Shabazz, Minister Malcolm X, who would have been 76 years old on May 19th. For the first time the mantel of leadership for the celebration of his life lies upon his daughter's shoulders since the passing of their mother, Betty Shabazz, last year. From four sites around Harlem, the community will assemble to honor Minister Malcolm X's memory.

Joining us today are representatives from faith-based institutions, schools, arts and cultural institutions, government agencies, corporations, and media, along with elected officials and dignitaries from around the world. A representative planning committee has provided input and support to make this the most inclusive community remembrance yet for one of Harlem's own sons.
